Application Guidelines

1 Contents of the project

Using the Niji-no-Plaza multipurpose hall as a base, artists will stay in the town for a certain period of time, interacting with the local community and creating works of art, with the aim of creating collaboration with the local community, bringing vitality to the area, promoting art, and fostering young artists. The purpose of the artist-in-residence program is to promote art and foster young artists. In order to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus infection, applications will only be accepted from artists who are staying or working in Japan.

3 Project period

Dec 6, 2021 - Dec 19, 2021 [5 to 10 days support during project period]

4 Number of applicants

1 person (In the case of a group, each group is counted as 1 person.)

5 Application Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions

(1) The applicant must be an artist or organization (hereinafter referred to as "artist, etc.") who is active in various fields of culture and arts and who is staying or working in Japan at the time of application. (1) The applicant must be an artist or organization (hereinafter referred to as "artist, etc.") who is active in various fields of culture and arts and who is staying or working in Japan at the time of application.

(2) Consideration must be given to the prevention of the spread of infectious diseases, including the new coronavirus, during travel and activities during the stay.

(3) Participants must produce at least one work of art and present it at a venue (either indoors or outdoors) in Oishida Town (including work-in-progress). At least one artist talk, lecture, workshop, or other community exchange event must be held at a venue in Oishida Town (either indoors or outdoors) during the festival period. It is also possible to conduct these events online, for example by using a web conference service.

(4) The applicant must be able to research, negotiate, and decide on the production location and venue for (3) above.

(5) The applicant must be able to interact with local residents and related organizations in a positive manner.

(6) Must be in good health. (6) Must be in good health, and upon request from Oishida, must report on his/her health during and after the stay.

(7) Health insurance, accident insurance, and travel insurance must be purchased by the artist. Insurance costs are not included in the support. Oishida Town is not responsible for insurance coverage.

(8) Please note that the project may be changed or cancelled due to the spread of the new coronavirus infection.

(9) Applicants must agree to the terms and conditions of the application and be able to take responsibility for the project from application to completion.

(10) The applicant must be able to communicate with others in Japanese or English. (10)
Applicants must be able to communicate in Japanese or English. If an interpreter is required, the cost of the interpreter shall be borne by the artist.

(11) The applicant must not have been delinquent in the payment of taxes to the municipality in which he/she resides for the past three years.

(12) The applicant must not have been sentenced to imprisonment without work or severer punishment, and must not have served the sentence until it is completed or until he or she is no longer subject to the sentence.

(13) The applicant must be 18 years of age or older.

(14) Make a record of your activities and submit the data within one month of the completion of your work.

(15) The work must not be a presentation of the results of an educational course or hobby activity.

(16) There should be no falsehoods about the submitted content.

6 Contents of Support

(1) Actual expenses for round trip transportation from Oishida to Kyoto at maximum

(2) Provision of a place to stay

(3) Rehearsal room and rehearsal space at the Niji no Plaza Theater

(4) Opportunity to present WS and work-in-progress

- (5) 70,000 yen per production (per performance)
- (6) Participation in community events, exchange, etc.
- (7) Travel by car within a 30km radius of Oishida Town
- (8) PCR test using ICheck, etc. and fee for issuing negative certificate

For the above, the organizer will pay the artists, etc. an honorarium based on the service contract within the budget, based on the support standards specified in the appendix. Note that insurance fees are not included in the support.

Expenses related to online implementation and the creation of flyers and posters for advertising and publicity are included in the production costs.

The payment of rewards will be made on the last day of the program.

If there is a violation of the application conditions, the applicant may be asked to return the expenses.

If necessary, the organizer can provide information about the production site, venue, accommodation, etc.

7 Record of Activities

The organizer will record the works and activities of the artists, etc. in this project with photographs and videos. We ask for your cooperation in documenting the activities of the organizers.

All copyrights of the works produced in this project belong to the artists, etc. However, the copyrights of the photographs, videos, etc. recorded by the organizer and the right to use them for publicity and promotion that serves the public interest belong to the organizer. The organizer and those who have received the organizer's approval may use all of these materials free of charge.
